The project ENFEM - Female TCNs Integration in local Communities through Employability and Entrepreneurship Local Oriented Strategies is co-funded under the AMIF programme of the European Union. It aims at providing opportunities for the creation and/ or development of local multi-stakeholder networks, in the 10 partner countries, composed of local authorities, market actors, NGOs, TNCs based, and women led organizations, where its overall vision will derive and be guided by the EU Action plan on integration and inclusion 2021-2027.

More specifically, the project will provide training opportunities to migrant women in the fields of language learning, working rights and entrepreneurship skills, while at the same time it will engage in awareness raising among local actors and citizens about the substantial benefits and positive impact of removing existing barriers to the inclusion of migrant women in the labour market.

The project consortium is comprised by 12 organisations from 9 EU countries. CEIPES, International Center for the Promotion of Education and Development is co-leading the implementation of the project activity in Italy.

After developing Local Integration Strategy in all partner countries and learning contents of two online courses, for migrant women and for Local Actors, partners are now ready to start implementing training and work-based learning activities
